

MASTER PLAN RENOVATION UPDATE

Since our congregational meeting, we continue to move forward on Phase I of the project to revitalize our property. We have solicited names of construction companies in an effort to select a Construction Manager and General Contractor (which may or may not be from the same company) to lead this project. After narrowing the field to either two or three businesses, Pat Ezerski, Mike Klatt, Jeff Milton and Pastor Tony will conduct interviews. We hope to complete this process in the next week or two.








CAFE JUSTO SALES BEGIN NOVEMBER 11




Ruminate: Conversations on Things That Matter

BRIEF: Southwest Conference United Church of Christ

The Southwest Conference released a statement this week endorsing Arizona Proposition 127. This ballot measure has the potential to significantly improve the quality of life for many Arizonans.

The Southwest Conference United Church of Christ's endorsement of Proposition 127 mirrors the long-standing tradition of the United Church of Christ taking action on environmental concerns. 44 General Synod resolutions dating back to 1959 have called people of faith to care for God's Creation. Taking a stand on and urging people to vote in a particular way on issues is permitted under IRS regulations without risking tax exempt status.
